Hospital receives SVCF grant

The Lindsborg Community Hospital is pleased to announce that it has been chosen as the recipient of a grant from the Smoky Valley Community Foundation. The grant will be used to purchase a fluid warmer for nursing services.

The IV Warmer is designed to warm one or two intravenous bags, of fluid, to body temperature and to hold those bags at that temperature. It is insulated so the fluid bags remain at optimum temperature for extended time periods.

An IV Warmer is particularly important for any and all patients who are hypothermic, diabetic, pediatric, burned or metabolically compromised. The IV warmer will also be used for trauma patients and many surgical patients.

Providing warmed IV fluids is technology that has every potential to improve patient safety, comfort and recovery outcomes of the patients seen by Lindsborg Community Hospital.
